11.4 TAPPING OF WATER MAINS AND OTHER CONNECTIONS:

It shall not be lawful for any person not specially authorized by the Board of Water Commissioners to tap any main of the Tannersville Water System or to make any connections therewith, or to in any manner interfere with said mains or any of them. Any violation of this ordinance shall be a violation and any person violating the same shall be subject to the penalties prescribed by the Penal Law of the State of New York for such conduct. However, in no case shall the fine exceed \$250.00 as prescribed by Section 20-210 (1) of the Village Law
