NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN THAT AFTER A PUBLIC HEARING HELD  
ON NOVEMBER 10, 1975, THE FOLLOWING ORDINANCE WAS ADOPTED

ORDINANCE  
REGULATING LAKE RECREATIONAL AREA

The Village Board of the Village of Tannersville, Greene County,  
New York does hereby ordain in accordance with the provisions of  
Village Law section 20-2002 as follows:

Section 1: No one shall be present on or enter upon  
Lake Recreation area between the hours of 11:00 P.M.  
to 6:30 A.M., except when Lake House Concession is  
open and in operation or supervisory personnel authorized  
by the Village Board are present; provided however, that  
a permit for a term of three months to use the Lake  
Recreation area during the prohibited hours referred  
to above may be granted by the Village Clerk on a  
showing of good cause by written application, setting  
forth the name and address of applicant and a statement  
of the uses of said area which the applicant intends  
to make.

1b: Any such permit may be revoked by a  
majority vote of the Village Board upon a finding of  
said Board that the privileges granted under the permit  
have been abused by the holder thereof.

Section 2: No vehicle shall be operated to a speed  
in excess to 15 miles an hour on Rip Van Winkle Lake  
Road from South Main Street to the intersection of  
Spruce Street.

Section 3: PENALTIES - Anyone violating the provisions  
of this ordinance shall be subject to a fine of Twenty  
Five and 00/100 (\$25.00) Dollars for each violation.

Section 4: SAVINGS CLAUSE - Should any section or  
provision of this ordinance be declared to be unconsti-  
tutional or invalid by the courts such decision shall  
not effect the validity of the ordinance as a whole or  
any part thereof other than the part so decided to be  
unconstitutional or invalid.

Section 5: EFFECTIVE DATE - This ordinance shall take  
effect ten (10) days after posting and publishing as  
required by Section 20-2004 of the Village Law.
