NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN, that after a Public Hearing held on March 18, 1976, the following Ordinance was adopted:

ORDINANCE #76-2  
REGULATING PARKING LOT AREA

The Village Board of the Village of Tannersville, Greene County, New York does hereby ordain in accordance with the provisions of Village Law Section 4-412 as follows:

Section 1: No Parking in Village Parking Lot on outside perimeter between the hours of 4:00 A.M. to 8:00 A.M. commencing November 1st. and ending April 1st. as follows:

- a.- East Side along Pratts Building
- b.- North Side along Creek
- c.- West Side along A & P Store


Section 2: PENALTIES - Anyone violating the provisions of this ordinance shall be subject to a fine of Twenty Five and 00/100 Dollars (\$25.00) for each violation.

Section 3: SAVINGS CLAUSE - Should any section or provision of this ordinance be declared to be unconstitutional or invalid by the courts such decision shall not effect the validity of the ordinance as a whole or any part thereof other than the part so decided to be unconstitutional or invalid.

Section 4: EFFECTIVE DATE - This ordinance shall take effect ten (10) days after posting and publishing as required by Section 20-2004 of the Village Law.

BE IT HEREBY ORDAINED BY the Village Board of the  
Village of Tannersville as follows:

§1. Title - Park<sup>ing</sup> Ordinance of the Village of  
Tannersville of 3 day of Nov., 1971

§2. No Parking -

a) Spruce Street - No parking is allowed on  
either side of Spruce Street from the bridge at the end  
of Railroad Avenue to the corporation line. OK

b) Hill Street - No parking is allowed on  
either side of Hill Street from Main Street to the corporation  
line. Parking west of the Showers' Building is not within  
the said Hill Street and is permitted. OK

c) Main Street - No parking is allowed on  
the north side of Main Street which is also State Route 23A  
anywheres within the Village limits. OK

d) No Parking - Church Street

e) No Parking Lake Road

§3. Time Limits on Parking -

a) No parking on the south side of Main Street  
as permitted by section 2 subparagraph c shall exceed 1 hour  
in duration for each parking of said vehicle. During 8:00 A.M.  
to 7:00 P.M. OK

b) No parking shall be allowed on Main Street  
from 4:A.M. to 7:00 A.M. to allow time for cleaning and  
snow removal.

§4. Penalties - Any person or persons violating this  
ordinance shall be liable to a penalty of not less that  
\$5.00 nor more than \$25.00.

§5. Savings Clause - Should any section or provision of this ordinance be declared to be unconstitutional or invalid by the courts, such decision shall not effect the validity of the ordinance as a whole or any part thereof other than the part so decided to be unconstitutional or invalid.

§6. Effective Date - This ordinance shall take effect 10 days after adoption and publication.
