Local Law No. 2 of the year 19 84

A local law known as "Regulation of Motorized Vehicles on Village Property of the Village of Tannersville"

Be it enacted by the Village Board of the

1. TITLE: This law shall be known as Regulation of Motorized Vehicles on Village Property of the Village of Tannersville Law.
2. LEGISLATIVE INTENT: Whereas the Village of Tannersville has an obligation to its citizens to maintain the peace and tranquility of the Village and to promote the general health and welfare of its inhabitants, it is in the best interests of said Village of Tannersville, its residents and visitors to regulate the creation or causing of nuisances, excess noise and other disturbances by recreational vehicles on lands belonging to the Village of Tannersville.
3. DEFINITIONS:
 - A. VILLAGE PROPERTY: Shall mean and refer to those lands owned or leased by the Village of Tannersville except that Village property shall not include any lands owned or leased by the Village of Tannersville solely for recreational and/or park purposes and Village streets.
 - B. MOTOR VEHICLE: Shall mean and refer to recreational motorized vehicles including but not limited to motorcycles, limited use motorcycles, off-highway motorcycles, motorized bicycles, mini bikes, mopeds, three or four wheeled motorized vehicles or carts, and snowmobiles.
4. VIOLATIONS:
 - A. No person shall operate any motor vehicle upon any Village property.
 - B. No person shall permit, cause, direct or allow the operation of motor vehicle upon Village property where such motor vehicle has been given, lent, leased or rented to such

shall permit and on such days and at such times as the Village may designate. Furthermore, snowmobiles shall be permitted to be operated on the Village Lake under such conditions as may be provided. Provided no snowmobile may be operated on the property of the Village Lake between the hours of 10:00 p.m. and 9:00 a.m. and may not be operated on any area designated for skating at the Village Lake.

D. The Village reserves the right to grant written permission to any person to operate a motor vehicle on such terms and conditions as the Village shall decide.

5. PENALTIES:

Any person convicted of operating a motor vehicle in violation of this Local Law shall be guilty of a violation and punishable by a fine of \$50.00 for the first violation within three years; a fine of \$100.00 for a second violation within three years; and a fine of \$250.00 for a third violation within three years.

6. SEVERABILITY:

Should any portion of this Local law be found to be unconstitutional or otherwise unenforceable by any court of the State of New York or the United States of America then the remainder of this Local Law shall be deemed to remain in effect.

7. EFFECTIVE DATE:

This Local Law shall take effect immediately upon filing with the Secretary of State.
