LOCAL LAW NO. 6 OF THE YEAR 1992

A local law Prohibiting the Distribution of Leaflets and Flyers on Public Streets.

Be it enacted by the Village Board of the Village of Tannersville as follows:

1. This Local Law shall be known as the Law Prohibiting Distribution of Flyers in the Village of Tannersville.

2. LEGISLATIVE INTENT The distribution of leaflets, flyers and advertising papers upon the public streets is an inconvenience to the public upon those streets and results in unsightly litter within the community. It is the purpose of this Local Law to prohibit such distribution.

3. DEFINITIONS:

(a) A leaflet or flyer is a sheet or sheets of material containing words, pictures or other advertising media.

(b) Advertising Papers are any other advertising throw away not included in paragraph (a).

4. PROHIBITION: There shall be no free distribution of leaflets, flyers or advertising papers on or to the public streets, sidewalks and parking areas within the Village of Tannersville to pedestrians, occupants of vehicles or other people.

5. PENALTIES: Any person firm, corporation or other entity found to be violating any of the provisions of this Local Law shall be guilty of an offense and upon such conviction shall be subjected to a fine in the amount of \$500.00 for each day that an offense hereunder occurs.

6. VALIDITY: The invalidity of any portion hereof shall not effect the validity of any other portion of this Local Law.

7. EFFECTIVE DATE: This Local Law shall become effective upon its filing with the Secretary of State of the State of New York.
