

VILLAGE OF TANNERSVILLE

LOCAL LAW 1 OF 1993

A Local Law to be known as

PROVISIONS FOR THE ENFORCEMENT OF UNPAID SOLID WASTE COLLECTION AND/OR DISPOSAL FEES THROUGH INCLUSION IN THE ANNUAL TAX LEVY IN ACCORDANCE WITH SECTION 120-cc OF THE GENERAL MUNICIPAL LAW
BE IT ENACTED by the Village of Tannersville Board of Trustees as follows:

1. TITLE

PROVISIONS FOR THE ENFORCEMENT OF UNPAID SOLID WASTE COLLECTION AND/OR DISPOSAL FEES THROUGH INCLUSION IN THE ANNUAL TAX LEVY

2. FINDINGS

The Village of Tannersville Board of Trustees finds the collection and disposal of illegal garbage bags, bags that are not labeled "Village of Tannersville", costly to the taxpayers of the Village and of serious health and aesthetic concerns. The Village therefore collects the illegal bags and imposes a special handling fee and/or violation upon the owner thereof.

3. PURPOSE

The Village of Tannersville Board of Trustees has found that the fees imposed on the owner are not always paid and therefore the Board is enforcing its power, pursuant to Chapter 228 of the Laws of 1992 which amends the General Municipal Law by adding a new Section 120-cc entitled "Enforcement of unpaid solid waste collection and/or disposal fee", to include these fees with any interest and penalty with the annual tax levy.

All unpaid fees or charges for the Village of Tannersville solid waste collection and /or disposal imposed on or after the effective date of this Local Law, including penalties or interest not paid by the date for levy of taxes of each year shall be added to the annual Village tax levy.

The Village of Tannersville Board of Trustees shall annually cause a statement to be prepared setting forth each amount of solid waste collection and/or disposal fees in arrears as of thirty days prior to the last date prescribed by law for the annexation of the warrant to the assessment roll, a brief description of the property for which or in connection with such solid waste services were provided and the name and address of the person or corporation liable to pay such amount. Such statement shall be presented to the Board of Trustees which shall levy such amounts remaining unpaid on the date taxes are levied against the real property for which or in connection with which such solid waste services were provided.

The Village of Tannersville Board of Trustees shall cause notice thereof to be sent to all delinquent users prior to the date for relieving the unpaid charges.

4. SEVERABILITY

If any part of this Local Law shall be declared unconstitutional, the same shall be severed from the remainder thereof which shall remain in full force and effect.

5. EFFECTIVE DATE

This Local Law shall take effect immediately upon being filed with the Secretary of State.
