A local law known as "VILLAGE OF TANNERSVILLE APPOINTED OFFICERS RESIDENCY LAW"

- TITLE.** This law shall be known as the Village of Tannersville Appointed Officers Residency Law.
- PURPOSE.** The purpose of this local law is to authorize and enable any person filling any position as an appointed officer of the Village of Tannersville to reside outside the corporate limits of the Village of Tannersville, but within the County of Greene, State of New York, so that the Village of Tannersville may avail itself of an increased labor and talent pool, and that appointed officials are not unduly restricted to the sole availability of domiciles within the Village of Tannersville.
- AUTHORIZATION.** This local law is enacted pursuant to NYS Village Law, Section 3-300(2), wherein, "the board of trustees of a Village may provide, in lieu of any other residency requirement imposed by law, that any appointed Village Officer may reside within a county in which the Village is wholly or partially situated."
- EXCEPTION.** Notwithstanding any other requirements of this local law, this local law shall have no effect upon any current or future residency requirement for appointed Officers of the Village of Tannersville Fire Department and, specifically, the positions of Chief, Assistant Chief, and Chief Driver shall be excepted from the requirements of this local law. Any person filling any such position shall and must reside either within Village of Tannersville corporate bounds or within the bounds of Town of Hunter Fire Protection Protection District Number Two to be eligible for such position.
- REQUIREMENT.** Except as otherwise provided for in Section 4 of this local law, the Village of Tannersville Board of Trustees does hereby require that any person appointed to any position as an appointed officer of the Village of Tannersville, whether such position is currently in existence or is subsequently created, including, but not limited to, Street Commissioner, Fire Commissioner, Superintendent of Public Works, Clerk-Treasurer, Deputy Clerk-Treasurer, Tax Collector, Code Enforcement Officer, Regulations Officer, Assessor, Registrar of Vital Statistics, and any member of any Village planning or Zoning Board or Commission, shall reside within the County of Greene, State of New York, and that said requirement shall be the sole residency requirement to hold any such position.

6. SEVERABILITY. If any word, phrase, or part of this local law shall be declared unconstitutional, the same shall be severed and separated from the remainder of this local law, and said remainder shall continue in full force and effect.

7. EFFECTIVE DATE. This local law shall take effect immediately upon filing with the Office of the NYS Secretary of State.
