RESOLUTION At a special meeting of the Village Board held on November 4, 1969 at 8:30 P.M. at the Village Hall, the following Village officers being present, Mayor Marvin Rubinger Trustee Robert Teetsel Trustee Frederick Fromer offered the following resolution: BE IT RESOLVED that in the interest of public health and public safety, and at the suggestion of William H. Byrne, President of the Tannersville Fire Department, the following streets be designated as streets on which no parking will be permitted from November 1 to April 15 of each year: 1. Gray's Lane Spring Street extension from intersection of Park Lane street to village line. The following streets will be designated as streets on which one-side parking only will be permitted from November 1 to April 15 of each year: Parking to be only on the West side Spring Street North side Fromer Street West side Park Lane З. 4. South side South Main Street North side Spruce Street 5. West side Raspberry Lane 6. West side Renwick Street 7. 8. North side Penrose Park

- 9. West side Tompkins Street
- 10. South side Lakeview Avenue
- 11. West side Church Street
- 12. Railroad Avenue west side in front of Palace Inn premises, no parking down through Dugway, west side from Penrose Park to Lakeview Avenue

PENALTIES - Any person violating any of the provisions of this ordinance shall be liable to a penalty of not less than \$5.00 or more than \$25.00. In addition thereto it is further ordained that a violation of any of the provisions of this ordinance shall constitute disorderly conduct and any person violating the same shall be and hereby declared to be a disorderly person; except, however, that if any statute of the State of New York does or shall declare the doing of any act or thing forbidden to be done by said ordinance to be disorderly conduct and to constitute the person so doing guilty of being a disorderly person, then and in that event such conduct and such persons are not hereby declared disorderly.
