WHEREAS, the Village has opened the multi-use path, from Bloomer Road to Clum Hill Road, for the recreational and educational use of the public, and

WHEREAS, the State grant for the path provided that no motorized vehicles should be permitted to use or pass over or upon the path, and

WHEREAS, the path surface is not blacktopped and there has been at least one serious accident involving a motorized recreational vehicle.

NOW, THEREFORE, it is unanimously resolved by the Board of Trustees of the Village of Tannersville, New York, that the following local law #99-1 be adopted to protect the public and enhance the safe use and enjoyment of the bike path:

Local Law #99-1

UNLAWFUL USE OF MOTORIZED VEHICLES ON OR OVER THE TANNERSVILLE BIKE PATH

(a) It shall be unlawful for any person(s) or entity to enter upon, pass over, or travel upon the Tannersville bike path using, traveling in or upon, or in possession of, any motorized vehicle or device.

(b) A "motorized vehicle" is defined as set forth in the New York State Vehicle and Traffic Law and shall include any vehicle or device or equipment which is or can be operated by any means other than the exclusive use of foot or hand power.

(c) A violation of this law shall be a class "A" Misdemeanor, punishable by a fine not to exceed \$500.00 and/or a prison term not to exceed one year.

(d) This law shall not apply to any repair or maintenance vehicle or equipment which is used upon the path for such purpose by any entity or person(s) having lawful authority or duty to effectuate such repair or maintenance.

(e) This law shall not apply to any vehicle or equipment used by a person(s) needing such equipment, vehicle or device to move or travel due to any temporary or permanent disability.
