## ***Minutes:***

The Mayor opened the meeting with the meeting with the Pledge of Allegiance.

The Mayor turned the floor over to Robert Hermance who stated he was here on behalf of Sergiy Yevtushenko on Main Street in Tannersville. He would like to do some do some work on his property. Mayor asked if he had any renderings. Mr. Hermance said no but could get them. The Mayor stated that as he is on Main Street, site plan review is required under zoning, so he can come in to the next meeting or if he can get it together sooner we can have a special meeting for planning. We just had public notification requirements which he can get from the clerk. Mr. Hermance said he would be fine with that and thank the board.

Highway Department report not submitted.

Trustee landers made a motion to approve the minutes from the April meetings. Trustee McGunnigle seconded. Trustee Walsh abstained from the April 27 meeting. All in favor, motion carried.

Trustee Kashman made a motion to approve the vouchers. Trustee McGunnigle seconded. All in favor, motion carried. The Mayor gave a copy of the tax warrant to the board. Includes amount of taxes levied against each parcel and applicable water relevies.

Trustee Kashman presented the board with a draft of the brochure. Mayor said to get comments back to him so we can get final printed and out before memorial day. Would like to be consistent with Kiosk panels.

Sean Mahoney asked the board if they would be open to entering into an agreement for making the entire Bear Square plaza for maintenance. They are looking for plowing and patching to be done by the Village. Trustee landers stated the Village only owns a portion of that plaza between the country store and Pratts. A board member asked if the other portion would be brought up to specks and dedicated to the Village. Mr. Mahoney stated he just wanted to approach the board and see if they would be open to have the discussion. The mayor stated to contact the Village attorney to get an opinion on this question.

Trustee Landers made a motion to adjourn. Trustee Kashman seconded. All in favor. Motion carried.
