Minutes:

The Mayor opened the meeting with the Pledge of Allegiance.

Budget Public Hearing

Mayor gave summary of budget. Mayor asked the board if there were any other comments or questions about the budget. He has received none thusfar.

Trustee McGunnigle Asked about an increase in one of the payroll categories. The clerk showed the board where the payroll was moved around and removed from street paving to street cleaning. This was reclassified per our most recent payroll audit with workers comp.

The Mayor stated that since we do not actually pave the streets and contract it out, it is more cost effective to have it classified at garage or street cleaning.

The Clerk added that when the men are at training or doing paperwork there was no real code for that either so we added a code to the budget for highway administration and that is where we will code the training and when they do paperwork, and time off.

Being there was no comment from the public the Mayor closed the budget public hearing.

Mayor opened the special meeting.

Special Meeting

Trustee McGunnigle made a motion to approve the budget for the 2018-2019 fiscal year commencing June 1, 2018. Trustee Kashman second. All in favor, motion carried.

Privilage of the floor

Trustee Landers stated we have to do some thing about the toilets in these buildings. No one is using them and we have had Garzone here 3 times because they are not working. They suggested there may be a collapsed pipe and to call lady rooter to repair. Could be expensive.

Board agreed that this was necessary and to get Lady Rooter here to camera ASAP and get estimates on repair. Perhaps we could do in house, but we need to know where pipe goes. DEP said it could go 2 ways based on their map.

Trustee Bain suggested Village purchase iPad for Village use rather than Clerk using hers. Mayor also said we should get a laptop for the office for use at meetings if there was money left in budget for clerical equipment. Clerk showed board amounts remaining. Board approved equipment purchases for office.

Trustee Bain also suggested another means of backup for the office other than to a thumbdrive. The Clerk pointed out all of our financials are backed up to the cloud provided by Williamson.

Trustee Bain suggested a wireless harddrive or via the cloud for her documents. Mayor told clerk to contact computer guy to see what he recommends and get pricing. If still money left in budget get what we need.

Mayor stated he wasn't in favor of cloud based. Trustee Bain suggested 2 so we could have offsite back up and swap out on a rotating basis.

Being that there was no other business, Trustee Landers made a motion to adjourn. Trustee Bain seconded. All in favor, motion carried.
